In our opinion, the work is of the period and closely relates to his style.

4. SCHOOL OF A N ARTIST

In our opinion, the work is by a pupil or a follower of the artist.

5. MANNER OF A N ARTIST

In our opinion, the work is in the style of the artist and is of a later period.

6. AFTER A N ARTIST

In our opinion, this work is a copy of the artist.

7. ASCRIBED TO A N ARTIST

In our opinion, this work is not by the artist, however, previous scholarship has noted this to be a work by the artist.

8. SIGNED (OR DATED)

The work has a signature (or date) which is in our opinion is genuine.

9. BEARS SIGNATURE (OR DATE)

The work has a signature (or date) which in our opinion is not authentic.


CONDITIONS OF SALE

Affecting purchasers and others attending the sale premises.

1. Purchasers will be deemed:
 - a) To have inspected their lots prior to the sale; and
 - b) To have accepted that lots are sold with all faults and imperfections specifically mentioned or not irrespective of whether they bid in person, by commission, online or through an agent.
2. All goods are second hand and sold without warranty unless otherwise stated in the sale catalogue or by the auctioneer from the rostrum. Any implied warranty, condition or other term is excluded except where to do so would be unlawful.
3. The auctioneers undertake that care has been taken to see that catalogue descriptions are accurate and reliable however these are matters of opinion only and shall not be taken to be statements of fact.
4. The auctioneers act as agents to the vendor and shall not incur liability to any purchaser for any statement, representation or warranty as to title, quality or otherwise of any lot made on behalf of and with the vendor's authority. Likewise the auctioneers shall incur no liability to a purchaser arising from any defect in goods sold save in the event of negligence on the part of the auctioneers or their employees. Any liability therefore shall be a matter for dispute between purchaser and vendor only.
5. The auctioneers reserve on behalf of themselves and the vendors the following rights:
 - a) To sell subject to a reserve price

8. If a dispute arises as to any bidding then at the discretion of the auctioneer either:
 - a) The lot to which the disputed bid relates shall immediately be offered again, or
 - b) The auctioneer shall determine the dispute and his decision shall be final and binding on all parties
9. a) At the fall of the hammer the purchaser is required to give their Client Registration Number. THE ESTATE OF PHILLIP ALLEN

1938 - 2022



Phillip was a regular face around W&H Peacock for many years, rarely missing a 'Robert Room' Antiques Sale and often popping into the weekly auctions.

Many regulars at Peacocks will remember Phillip as an interesting and friendly character who really 'knew his stuff'. Whenever he was in the saleroom, Phillip was surrounded by others wanting to question him and learn from his vast knowledge, particularly of Oriental ceramics.

Phillip Allen was born in Birmingham in 1938. He started collecting antiques at the young age of 12 after being influenced by his aunt and uncle. Phillip was an avid reader and was always keen to expand his knowledge. He spent his career at Birmingham Central Library where he was initially the head of language and literature and later moved to become the head of the history and geography departments. During the 1960's and 70's he spent time in Iran where he made many friends and gained a lasting respect for Persian culture and cuisine.

Phillip was a valued council member of the Oriental Ceramic Society, contributing six articles to the Transactions of the Oriental Ceramic Society between 1988 and 2012 on topics ranging from Yixing wares, ivories, the use of porcelain in English homes and the repair of porcelain. During his retirement, Phillip became the traveller organiser for the OCS and arranged various trips for members in the UK and abroad. He also worked for the Sir Victor Sassoon Ivories Trust, becoming its honorary secretary, and was instrumental in organising their bequest to the British Museum. Along with Rose Kerr and Shih Ching-fei, Phillip spent two years working on a catalogue of the Sassoon collection, which was photographed by Phillip's friend Shahid Amin.

Recently a Chinese Zitan treasure chest belonging to Phillip sold for £125,000.

The team at W&H Peacock have been thrilled to search through Phillip's collection, finding all manner of quirky and interesting objects hidden away in cabinets and cupboards. We are now pleased to offer for sale this further collection of Oriental pieces from Phillip's home in Bedford.
