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A 17th century and later Antwerp School ebony, tortoise-shell and brass mounted cabinet decorated with sixteen painted-on-glass panels depicting mythological and allegorical subjects, reflecting the Antwerp pictorial trend of the early 17th century. The central door with barley twist Corinthian columns revealing a bone and ebony parquetry floor and mirrored sides, surrounded by ten drawers over the base with brass guilloche moulding and inlaid frieze, on later legs, h. 143 cm, w. 182 cm, d. 51 cm











*This cabinet is one of the rare emblematic works of the city of Antwerp, a collaboration between a painter and a cabinetmaker and intended to adorn a Kunstkammer (private museum) or an art cabinet. The central panel depicts a blindfolded putto, Cupid, the symbol of Love & Truth. Blind Tiresias is at the centre, with Venus, Mars/Adonis and Cupid on the right-hand side. The cabinet shows scenes from Ovid's 'Ars Amatoria'- The Art of Love- and would have been given as a wedding present. The Art of Love was written in 2 AD and is an instructional elegy in three books. Book One show a man how to find a woman, Book Two Ovid shows how to keep her, Book Three gives advice on how to win and keep the love of a man. All the painted scenes refer to subjects from Ovid's poem.






